

MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF JULY 2, 2012

Call to Order: The Regular Meeting of Mayor and Council of July 2, 2012 was called to order by Mayor Pro-tem Sparkle Adams at 7:00 p.m.

Invocation: The invocation as given by Councilwoman Linda Lord followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Approval of Minutes: Ms. Lord made a motion to approve the minutes of the Work Session and Regular Meeting of June 18, 2012, seconded by Ms. Akins. Voting for the motion was unanimous.

Comment Period: Carl Evans – thanked everyone involved for the Voter Forum recently held and complained of ongoing issues with Waste Management

Mr. Glenn Barnett spoke concerning problems with the Public Works Department and Waste Management issues.

Resolution: Request was made to consider a Resolution by the City Council of the City of Forest Park authorizing the Mayor to execute a License Agreement with Forest Park Youth Football for the use of Kiwanis Stadium, Lopez Field, Baker field, Burke Field, Stanford Field and Johnson Field from July 23, 2012 through November 21, 2012 to conduct football and cheerleading practices and games in their Youth Football Program, game dates are: August 18, 25, September 1, 15, 22, 29, October 6, 13, 27 and November 3, 2012; to provide for severability; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes.
