REGULAR MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF FEBRUARY 16, 2015

- Call To Order: The Regular Meeting of Mayor and Council of February 16, 2015 was called to order by Mayor David Lockhart at 7:00 p.m.
- Invocation: The invocation was given by Mr. Willie Finch followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.
- Roll Call: Mayor David Lockhart and Councilmembers Latresa Akins, Dabouze Antoine, Maudie McCord, Tommy Smith and Linda Lord.

- Approval of Minutes: Ms. Akins made a motion to approve the minutes of the Work Session and Regular Meeting of February 2, 2015, seconded by Mr. Smith. Voting for the motion was unanimous.
