SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND: The Forest Park Braves are requesting use of Lockhart Field and concession stand March 21, 2012 through September 30, 2012 to conduct baseball games and practice. Practices are Wednesday from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Games are Sunday from 1 to 5 p.m. The License Agreement is a revocable License Agreement and specifications for the use of City of Forest Park facilities and vending concessions and includes liability insurance, general release, indemnification and hold harmless provisions.
