

MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF APRIL 16, 2012

- Call to Order: The Regular Meeting of Mayor and Council of April 16, 2012 was called to order by Mayor Corine Deyton at 7:00 p.m.
- Invocation: The invocation was given by Rev. Wanda Curry followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.
- Roll Call: Present were: Mayor Corine Deyton, Mayor Pro-tem Sparkle Adams, Councilwomen Linda Lord, Latresa Akins and Maudie McCord.
- Also present were City Manager John Parker, Director of Finance Mike Blandenburg, Director of Public Works Mike Gippert, Director of Support Services Christine Terrell, Director of Planning and Zoning Al Wiggins, Deputy Director of Recreation and Leisure Services Sharon Smith, Major Chris Matson, Major David Halcome, Management Analyst Angela Redding and City Attorney Robert Mack and Joe Harris.
- Approval of Minutes: Ms. McCord made a motion to approve the minutes of the Work Session and Regular Meeting of April 2nd and the Work Session of April 3rd, seconded by Ms. Akins. Voting for the motion was unanimous.
- Comment Period: Dianne Lunsford – Ms. Lunsford acknowledged and praised the Fire Department, Station 2. She stated this is the second time in four months, they have saved one of her elderly neighbors. She thanked the Fire Department Paramedics for their care, training and education.
- Kimberly James – Ms. James spoke concerning some issues and concerns regarding the City.
- Carl Evans – reminded everyone of the Northside Neighborhood Watch Meeting and Northside Clean Up on the 21st.
- Mike Gippert explained that the City is entering into a Contract with Waste Management for solid waste and recycling. He then explained the new recycling program that will be implemented June 4th.

Agreement with Waste Management: Request was made to consider an Agreement with Waste Management for Solid Waste Collection and Recycling.

Ms. Adams made a motion to waive the 48 notification required for Ordinances and approve the Ordinance by the City Council for the City of Forest Park, Georgia, to authorize execution of a contract with Waste Management, Inc. to provide Residential and Commercial Solid Waste and Collection and Disposal Services for the City; to repeal all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes, seconded by Ms. McCord. Voting for the motion was unanimous.

Lease Agreement (Claire Redman): Request was made to consider a Lease Agreement between the City of Forest Park and Claire Redman (964 Longleaf Drive) to lease City property.

Ms. Lord made a motion to approve the Lease Agreement, seconded by Ms. Adams. Voting for the motion was unanimous.

Adjournment: Ms. Adams made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ms. McCord. Voting for the motion was unanimous.
