

## MINUTES

### REGULAR MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF MARCH 19, 2012

Call to Order: The Work Session of Mayor and Council of March 19, 2012 was called to order by Mayor Corine Deyton at 7:00 p.m.

Invocation: The invocation was given by Rev. Kenneth Paden of Living Word Church followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Approval of Minutes: Ms. McCord made a motion to approve the minutes of the Work Session and Regular Meeting of March 5, 2012, seconded by Ms. Lord. Voting for the motion was unanimous.

New Retail Alcohol License – White Shoe, Inc.

Ms. McCord made a motion to approve the new Retail Alcohol License from White Shoe, Inc., seconded by Ms. Lord. Voting for the motion was unanimous.

Resolution - License Agreement with Forest Park Braves:

Request was made to consider a Resolution by the City Council of the City of Forest Park authorizing the Mayor to execute a License Agreement with Forest Park Braves for the use of Lockhart Field from March 21, 2012 through September 30, 2012 to conduct Baseball games; to provide for severability; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes.

Ordinance - Community Economic Adjustment Planning Assistance Grant:

Request was made to consider an Ordinance by the City Council of the City of Forest Park authorizing the Mayor to sign and accept a Community Economic Adjustment Planning Assistance Grant for Calendar Years 2011 and 2012 from the Department of Defense Office of Economic Adjustment for the purpose of preparing an outreach and comprehensive Reuse Plan for Fort Gillem and to appropriate the matching funds from the transfer to LRA Fund Line Item 100-22-1510-61-1001; to provide for severability; to repeal all Ordinances and parts of Ordinance in conflict herewith; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes.

Ms. Lord made a motion to approve the Ordinance, seconded by Ms. Adams. Voting for the motion was unanimous.

Resolution - Agreement Between Forest Park/Ft. Gillem ILRA & Forest Park Development Partners:

Request was made to consider a Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Execute the Development and Disposition Agreement by and between the Forest Park/Fort Gillem Implementation Local Redevelopment Authority and the Forest Park Development Partners, LLC.

Ms. Akins made a motion to approve the Resolution, seconded by Ms. Lord. Voting for the motion was unanimous.
