SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND: The Places of Assembly Ordinance was adopted by the Mayor and Council in February 2007 in an effort to maintain the safety and general welfare of the City of Forest Park and to establish a methods of balancing retail development and other commercial uses as outlined in the City's Comprehensive Development Plan. The terms of the Places of Assembly ordinance regulates the distance of certain uses through a distance measurement formula.
