SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND: Clayton County Public Schools is requesting use of Kiwanis Stadium for the 2012-2014 school year. The dates requested are September 5th, 11th, 18th, 25th, October 2nd, 9th, 2012. The fee will be at a rate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) for field and Fifty Dollars (\$50) for concession stand per date for uses of Kiwanis Stadium. The Intergovernmental License Agreement is a revocable License Agreement with specifications for the use of City of Forest Park facilities and vending concessions and includes liability, insurance, general release, indemnification and hold harmless provisions.

3. Consider an Ordinance by the City Council for the City of Forest Park, Georgia to amend Title 3, Chapter 3 entitled “Occupational, Profession and Business Taxes, in its entirety to update the methods for determining the amount of said taxes; to repeal all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes.
