- Approval of Minutes: Councilwoman Bagley made a motion to approve the minutes of the Work Session and Regular Meeting of July 17, 2017. Councilman Smith seconded the motion. The motion carries unanimously in favor of the motion.

- Resolution: Resolution by the City Council of the City of Forest Park declaring certain City property, listed on "Exhibit A", to be surplus property and to provide for its proper disposal either by auction or other methods pursuant to the City's ordinances; and for other purposes.

Resolution: Resolution by the City Council of the City of Forest Park
FPYF authorizing the Mayor to execute a License Agreement with Forest Park Youth Football for the use of Kiwanis Stadium, Lopez Field, Baker Field, Burke Field, Stanford Field and Johnson Field from July 24, 2017, through November 18, 2017, to conduct football and cheerleading practices and games in their Youth Football Program. Game dates are: September 2, 16; October 7, 21; and November 4, 2017; to provide for severability; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes.

Councilwoman Wells made a motion to adopt this Resolution. Councilwoman Bagley seconded the motion. Motion carries unanimously in favor of the motion.

Resolution: Resolution by the City Council of the City of Forest Park
Tahoe Purchase authorizing the use SPLOST funding to purchase five 2018 Chevrolet Tahoe police vehicles from Hardy Chevrolet in the amount of \$171,699 for general police purposes; to provide an effective date; and for other purposes.
