SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND: South West Atlanta Christian Academy has requested use of Kiwanis Stadium for October 5th and October 26th, 2012. The fee will be \$150 for field and \$50 for the concession stand per date for use of Kiwanis Stadium. The License Agreement is a revocable License Agreement with specifications for the use of City of Forest Park facilities and vending concessions and includes liability insurance, general release, indemnification and hold harmless provisions.
